PROCEEDINGS OF THE 11TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING ("AGM" or "the Meeting") OF GENUS PAPER & BOARDS LIMITED ("the Company") HELD ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2022 AT 11:30 A.M. (IST) THROUGH VIDEO CONFERENCING OR OTHER AUDIO VISUAL MEANS AND CONCLUDED AT 12:15 P.M. (IST)

- Mr. Anuj Ahluwalia, Company Secretary of the Company welcomed the Members to the Meeting and informed them on details relating to their participation at the Meeting through VC/OAVM and e-voting during the AGM. He further informed the Members that the Company had provided remote e-voting facility to the Members to exercise their right to vote on the business items transacted at the AGM, by electronic means, from Saturday, September 24, 2022 at 09.00 am to Monday, September 26, 2022 at 05.00 pm as stated in the Notice of AGM.
- Mr. Ishwar Chand Agarwal, Chairman of the Company could not attend the AGM due to some exigencies.
 With the permission of all Directors, present and on behalf of the Directors, Mr. Kailash Chandra Agarwal,
 Managing Director & CEO of the Company presided over the Meeting.
- The Chairman of the Meeting informed that the Meeting was held through VC/OAVM in compliance with the circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India (MCA) and the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI).
